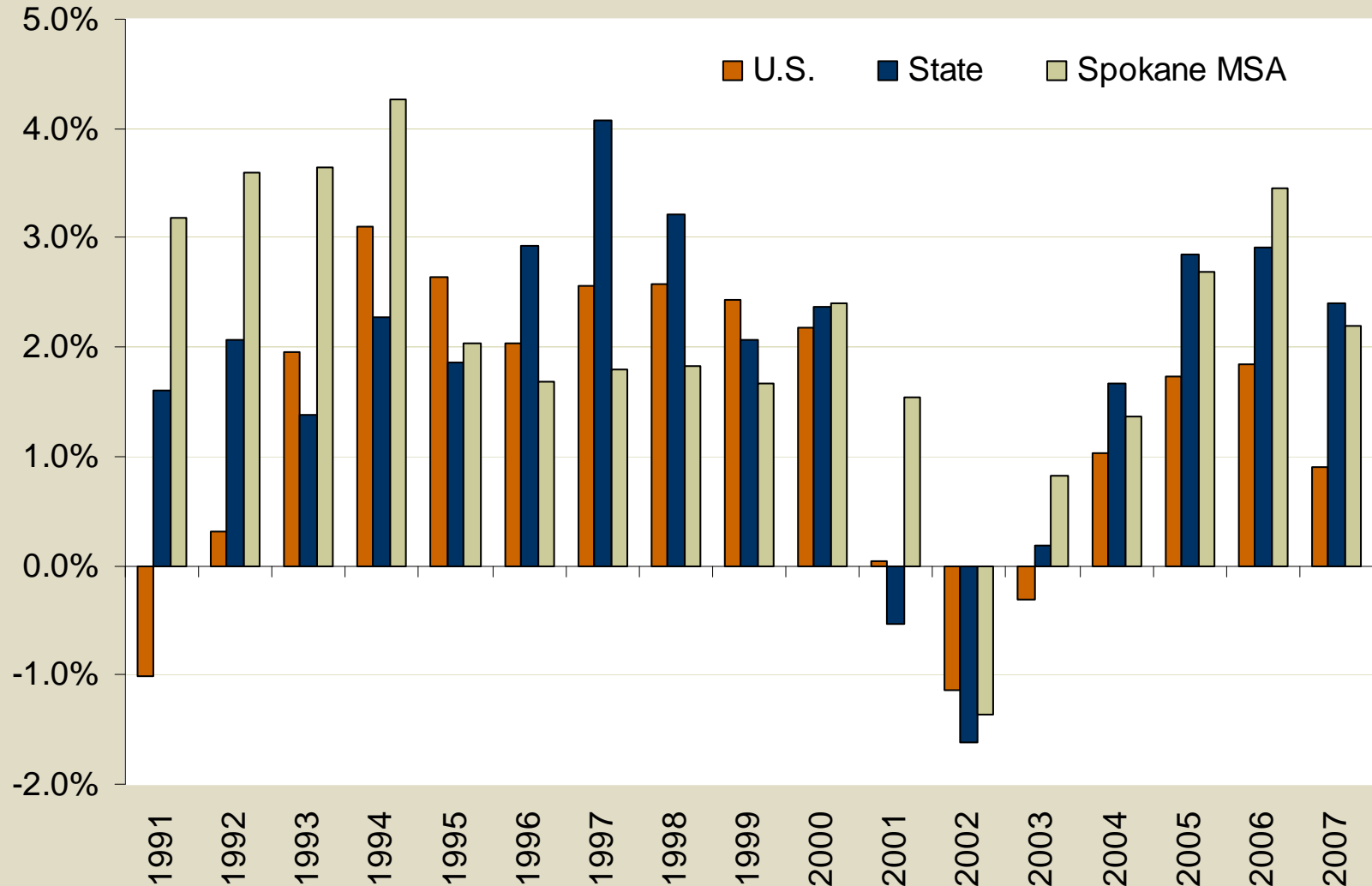


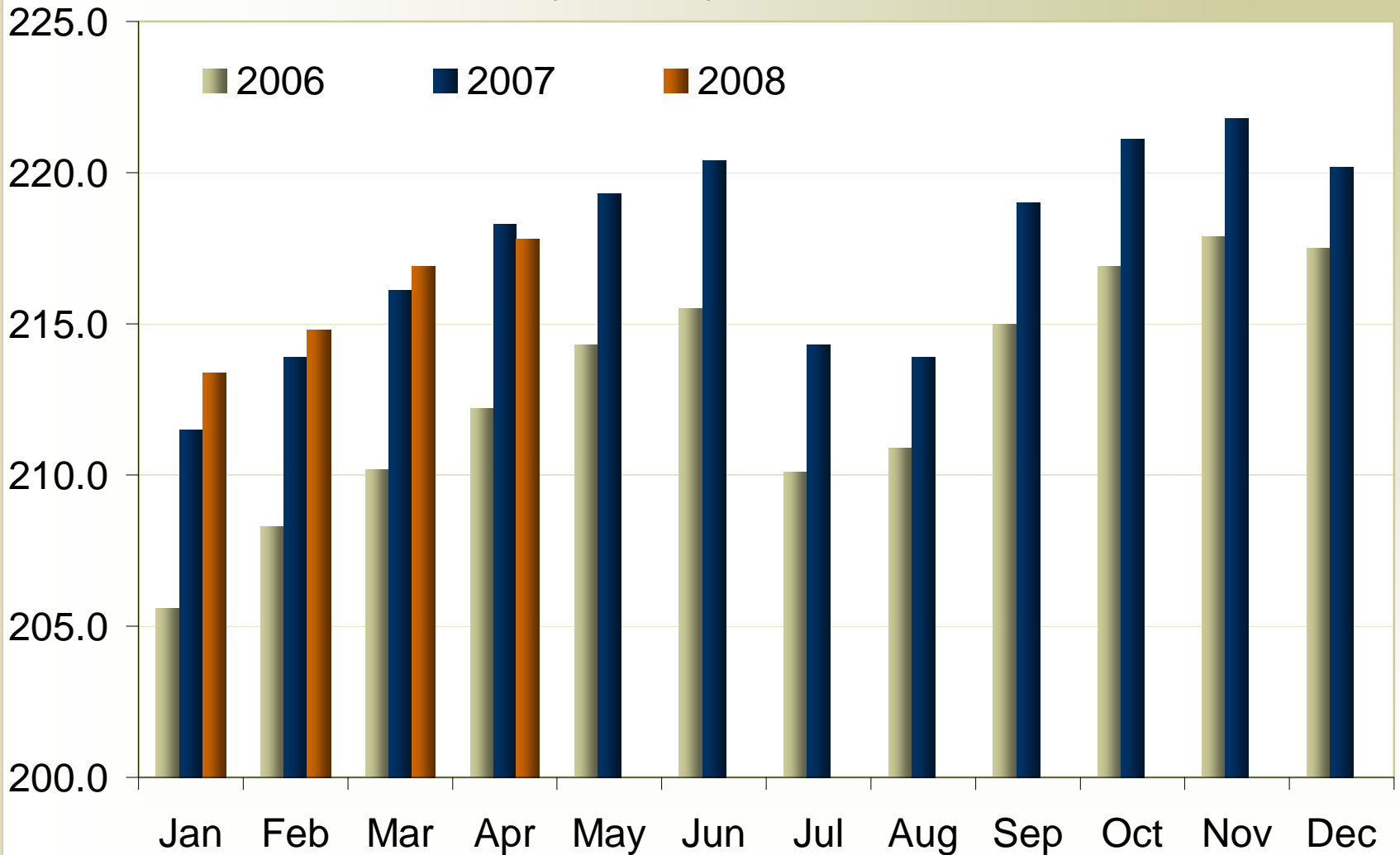
# Annual Growth in Nonfarm Employment 1991-2007



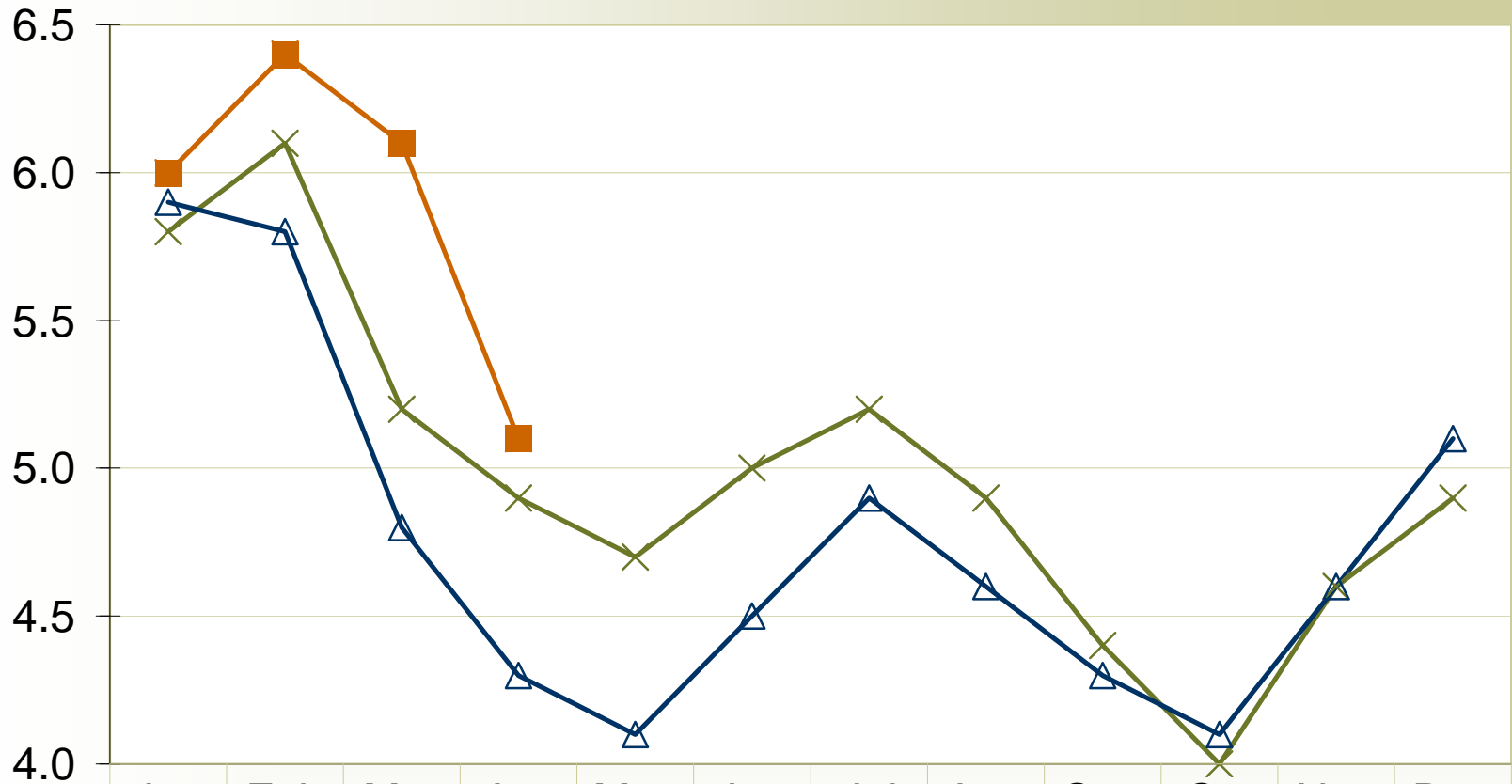

## Spokane MSA (Spokane County) Nonfarm Industry Employment (numbers in 000s)

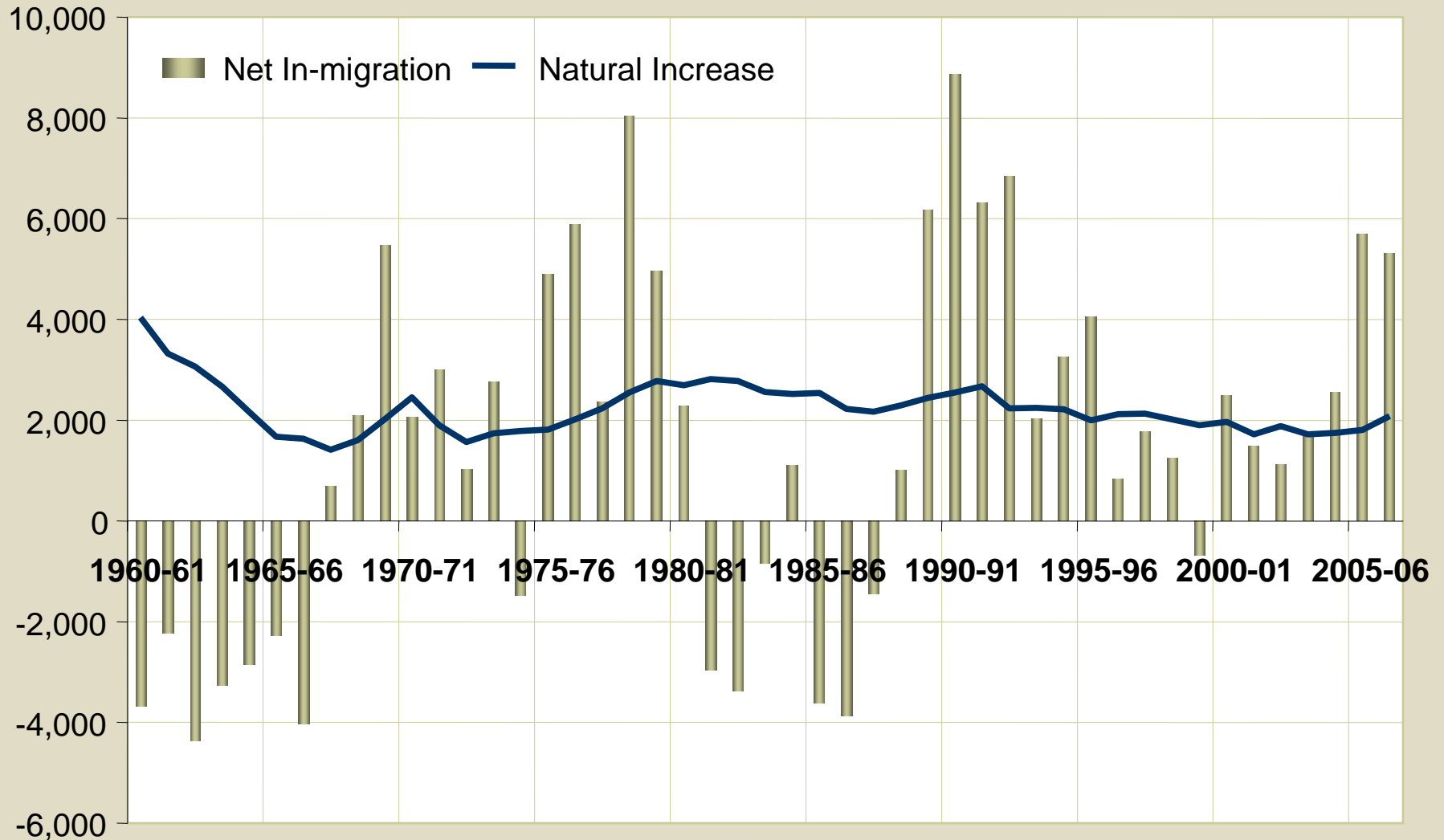


## Spokane MSA (Spokane County) Unemployment Rate Percentages

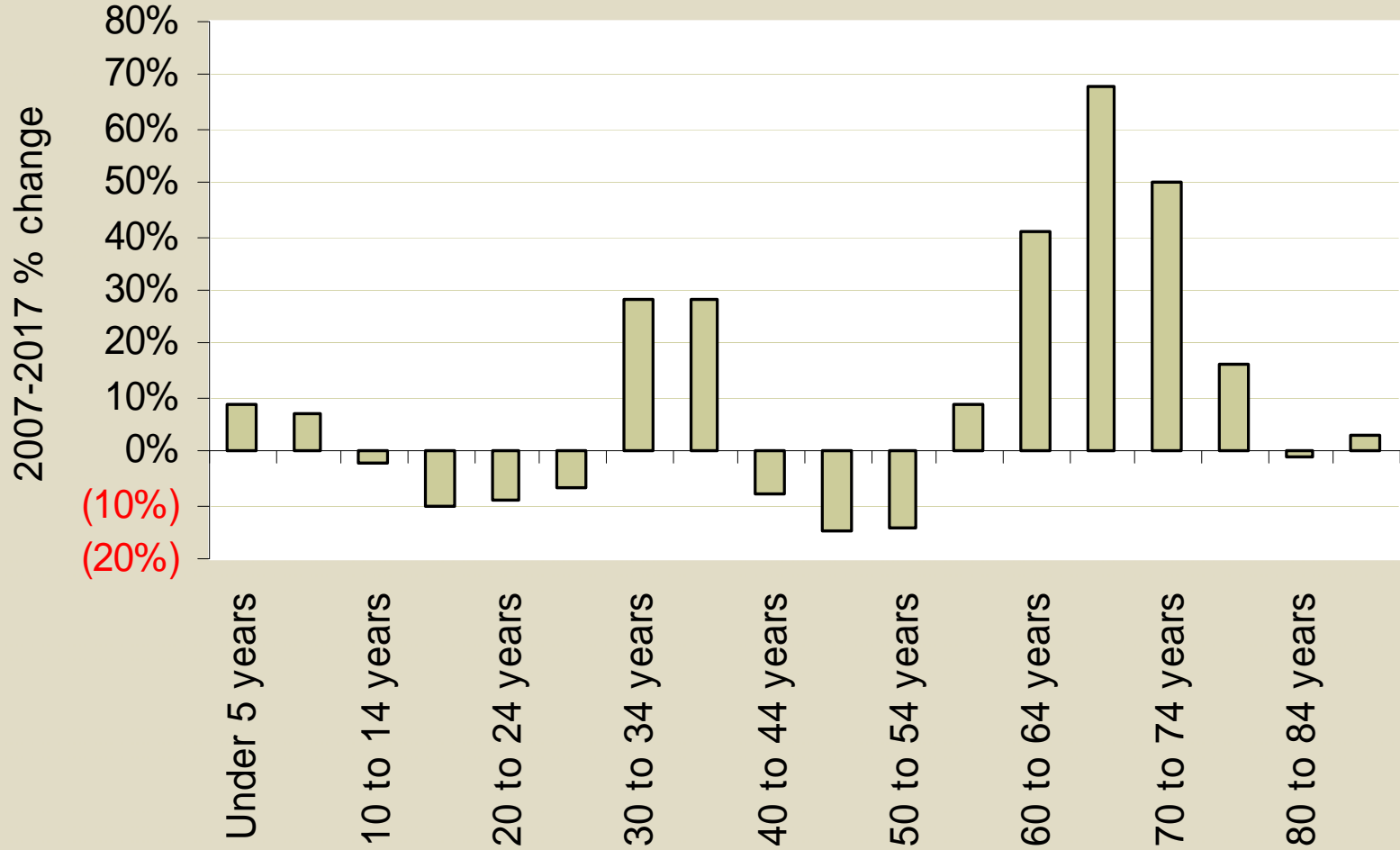
# Annual Natural Increase and Net In-migration Spokane County

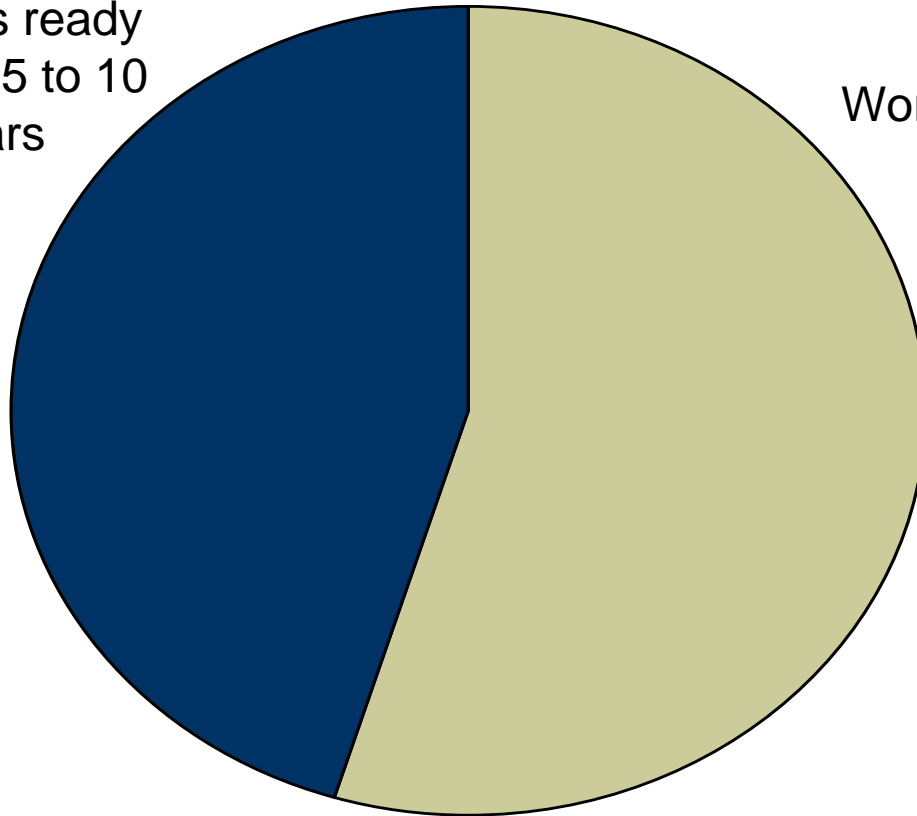


# Growth by Age, Spokane



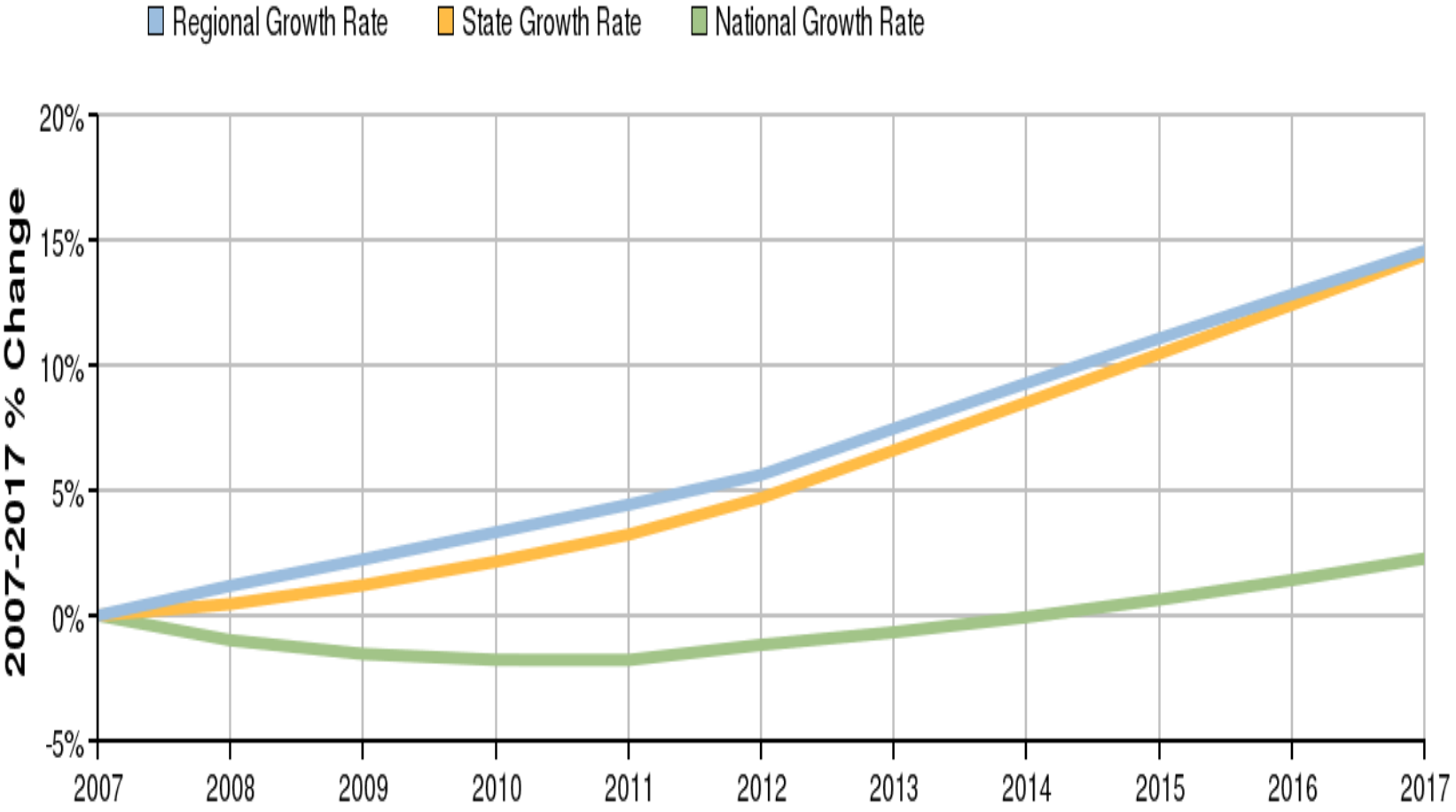

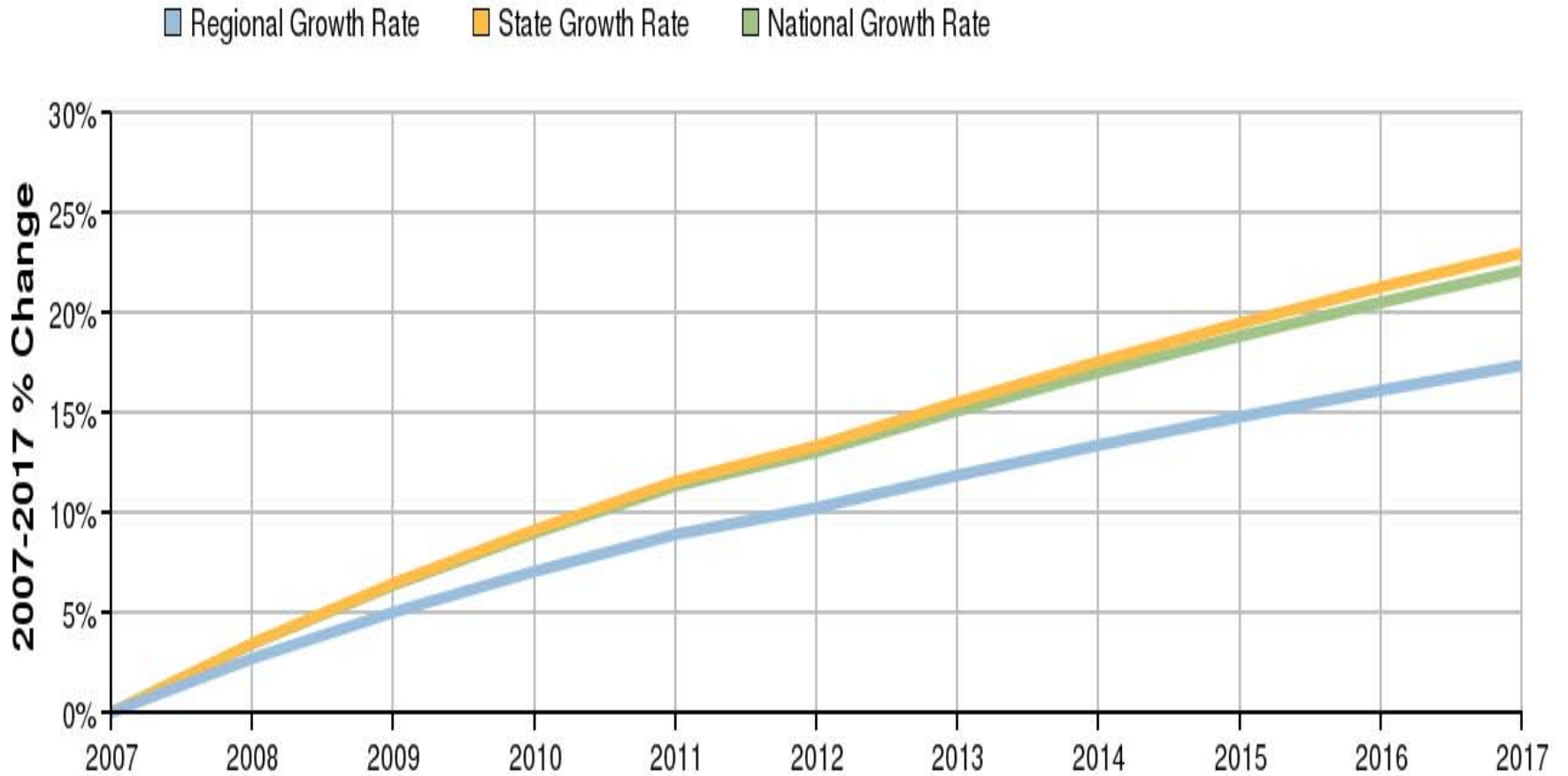
