[Measurements:]

- Completion of work readiness skill goal: min. of 6 hours of workshop which included learning skills on how to get and keep a job, resume writing, budgeting and workplace safety
- Successful completion of work experience: minimum of 120 hours

- Total budget is \$1.5 million dollars
- YTD spending is \$926,009
- Projected spending by 9/30/09 is \$1,216,000

Waiver

- The budget is being evaluated to see possible unspent dollars past 9/30/09 before deciding on how to proceed with waiver
