Use the higher of either the HHS Federal Poverty Guidelines or the 70% Lower Living Standard Income Levels (LLSIL). NOTE: For a family of one, the HHS Federal Poverty Guidelines is higher than the 70% LLSIL. The 70% LLSIL is higher for all other family sizes.

Calculation - full time employed - Annual Salary divided by 2080 hours per year = hourly rate.
